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MEETING MINUTES

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve minutes from the September 2023 meeting was unanimous. Motion to approve the minutes from the April 2023 meeting was unanimous.

ELECTIONS

Bruce Collins is President of the SCC for the 2023-24 school year. Maggie Blau was approved as Vice President. Rachel Pehrson was approved as Secretary.

RULES OF ORDER AND PROCEDURE

SCC Council Responsibilities were reviewed. Bylaws and procedures from the state were also reviewed and compared to Hayden Peak's written Rules of Order and Procedure. Hayden Peak SCC Rules of Order and Procedure were approved unanimously.

SAFE WALKING ROUTE - SNAP MAP

Kristine reported what she learned from talking to an officer. The officer recommended asking the city traffic engineer to help do a car count. The crossing guards might be able to help with pedestrian counts at the cross walks. A concern was brought up about students walking to breakfast who have to cross before the guards are on duty. Ideas from the council included adding flashing lights at the blind corner for pedestrians to activate, a "No Parking on School Days" sign, and inviting the city officials to an SCC meeting. Bruce will begin by reaching out to the city council for help and report back to the SCC via email.

SCHOOL DATA

Principal Fisher reviewed the School Report Card from USBE based on school RISE data from spring testing. Hayden Peak had a very high participation rate at 99.9%. ELA and Science scores rose from the previous year by 4.0% and 4.9% respectively. Math scores dropped by 1.8%. Scores in all three areas are comparable to both district and state averages. Growth scores for Hayden Peak are listed as exemplary with 6.5% growth for the lowest 25% of students. The school average of English Learners making adequate progress is above district and state averages.
