

# Hayden Peak Elementary School Community Council Meeting

## **Crossing guard at 7800 S.**

The crossing guard is keeping track of numbers of students using the cross on 7800 S. & 4800 W., but numbers are very low. The guard will be there until the end of this school year and will continue to keep track of numbers to see if there's an increase in warm months. It will be reevaluated by the city at the end of the school year to determine if there is a need for that crossing guard for next year. If the crossing guard is removed from that location, an alternate route would need to be approved and updated on the safe walking route. One possibility is to have students cross at the roundabout from the west side of 4800 W. to the east side.

**Proposal:** Could the city consider installing speed bumps at the 7800 roundabout like they have at the roundabout by Smiths to make that crossing safer?
