Safety Plan with Covid 19

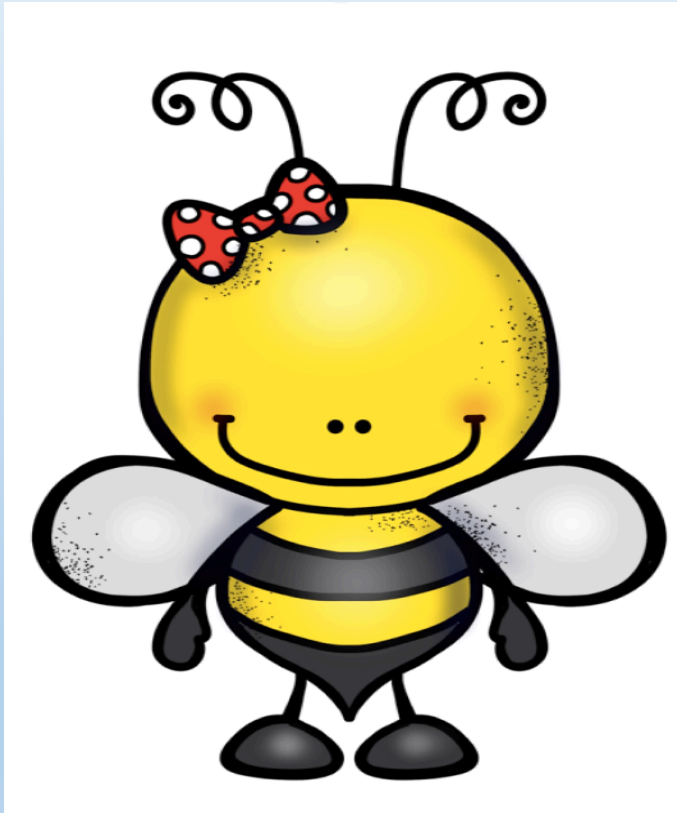

Daily Checklist for your child

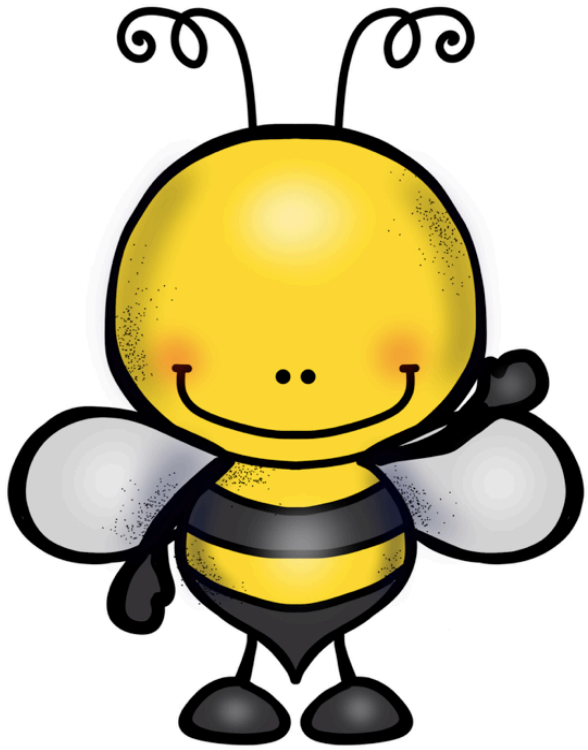
- ✓ Wear a mask every day.

Birthdays

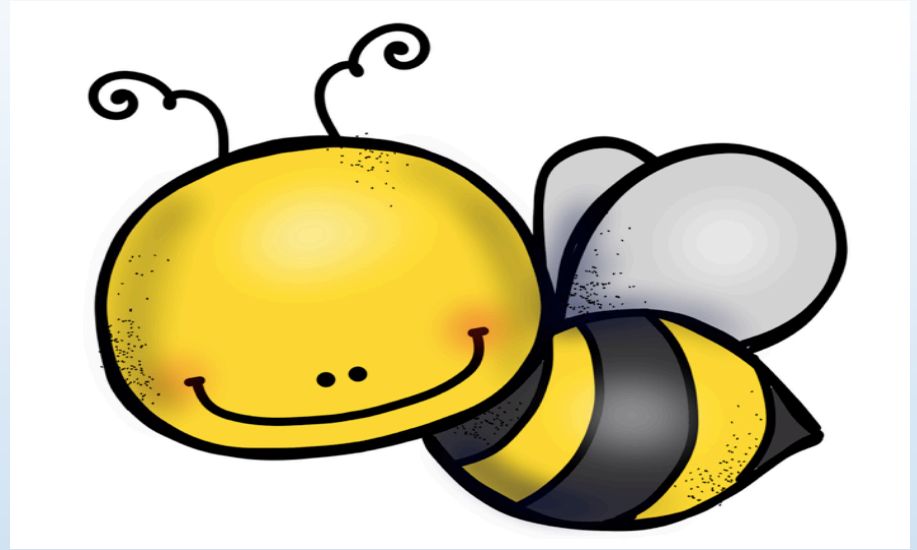


We will still celebrate your child's birthday at school, however we can no longer accept treats or items from outside the building to pass out.

12:00- Lunch

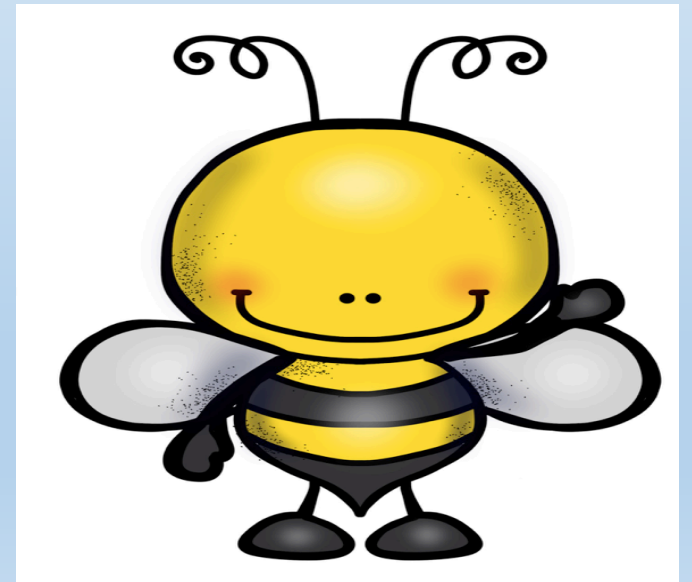
12:40- Language Arts and Math skills

1:00- Math Interventions

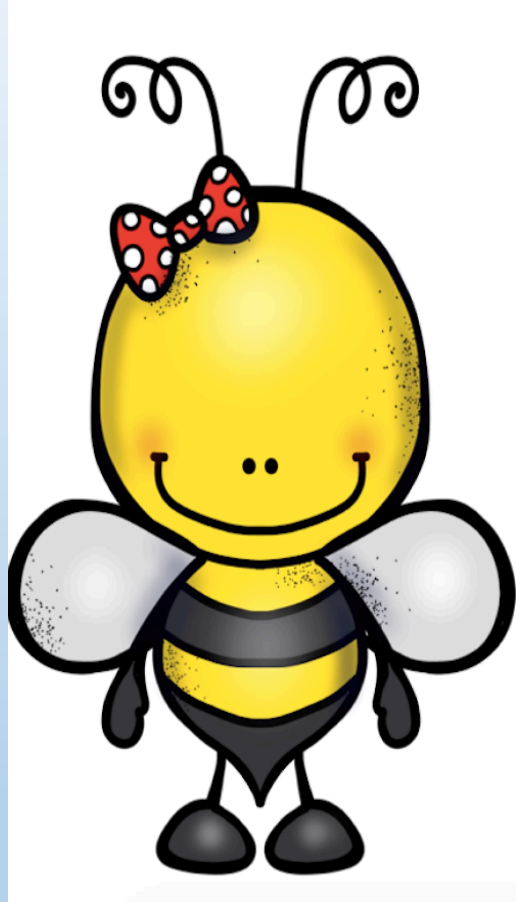
1:30- Specials (Social Skills, Library, PE, Music and Art)

Lunch



- ✓ We will line up in our classroom in number order (each child will have a number assigned to them).
- ✓ If you brought a lunch from home, you will get it out of your backpack before lining up. **if bringing lunch from home, we encourage you to use disposable items that can be thrown away instead of a lunchbox**
- ✓ When we go in the lunchroom we will sit on our class number. Those that brought a lunch can go ahead and find their number and get started eating. Those that are getting a school lunch will continue down one way, get their lunch tell the lunch lady their number and name and then walk back to our class table and find their number. So our class will be sitting together at lunch and playing together at recess.



Friday

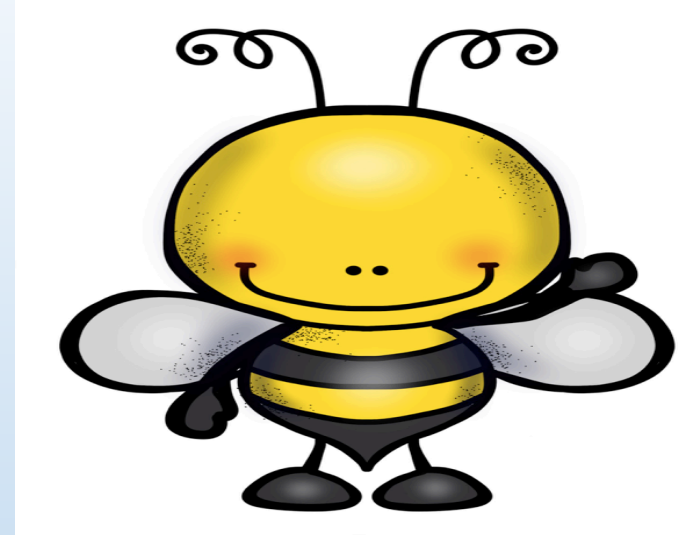
This year Fridays will be unique.

- ✓ **Students will not attend school, but will have an assignment or activity to complete at home.**
- ✓ **They should also read for 20 minutes.**
- ✓ **Some students will be invited to come and work individually or in small groups with me, their teacher.**
- ✓ **If your child is invited, I will be contacting you and your child will bring home a “golden ticket” on Monday. The ticket has information about crossing guards and lunches. Your child would come from 10:30-1:25 with a lunch from 12:55-1:25. They may bring a lunch or purchase one from the school. They will also need to bring their “golden ticket” to get into the school on that Friday.**

Behavior

Classroom Expectations:

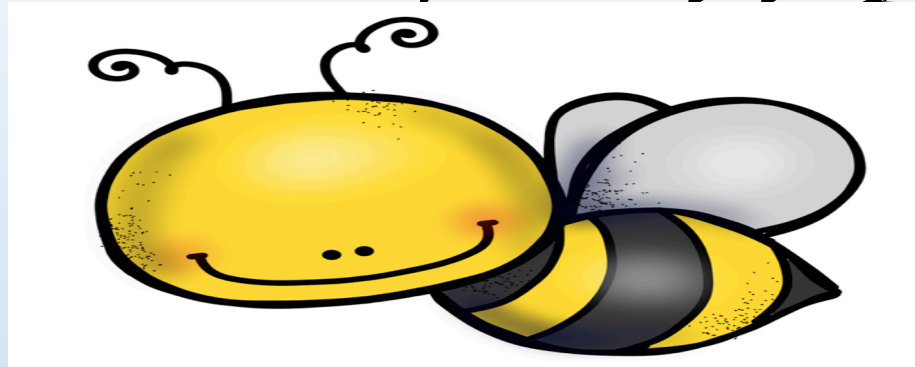
- ✓ Listen and follow directions the first time given.
- ✓ Follow the voice sign.
- ✓ Keep hands, feet, mouth and objects to yourself.
- ✓ Stay on task.
- ✓ Use kind words.



I believe in positive reinforcement. As rules are followed the students will be rewarded with positive praise, treats, brag tags, tallies on “busy bee” chart and Hawkeyes.

However, when rules are broken there will be consequences too. I use a “clip up or clip down” system. They clip up when they are keeping rules and clip down when they don’t. Every student starts in the middle each day and records where they end up in their leadership notebooks at the end of the day. All the way to the top receives a Hawkeye. All the way to the bottom will be a phone call to parents. This helps them be reminded of their behavior and make changes if necessary.

7 Habits of Happy Kids



In my class, we are incorporating the “7 Habits of Happy Kids.” This helps students believe that they are leaders. I want to give them the opportunity to shine with their strengths. We will be learning Stephen Covey’s 7 Habits which teach students how to be in charge of themselves and how to work well with others. Hopefully your child will demonstrate at home what they are learning at school.

I will do my best to make a learning environment where every child can succeed and feel important. I’m so excited to get to know your child and work with you to make second grade a fantastic year for all of us.
