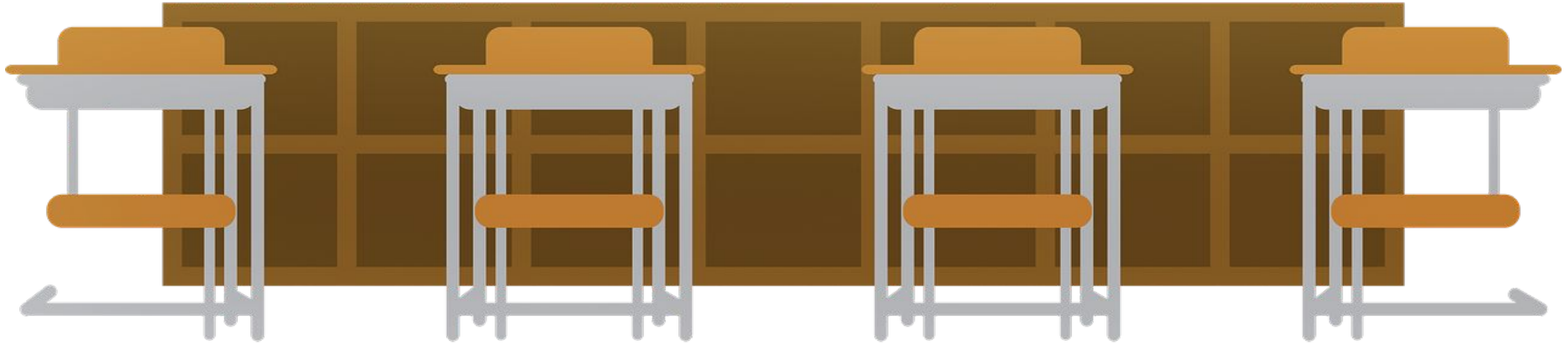

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# Third Grade Specials

All specials will be taught in our classroom.

- **Monday:** STEAM- A new teacher will be teaching us about artists, science, technology, engineering and mathematics.
- **Tuesday:** Music- Mrs. Michaelis is back for more music fun.
- **Tuesday:** Art- Mrs. Foote is returning for art instruction.
- **Wednesday:** Second Steps- A new exciting character education class.
- **Thursday:** PE- Will be outside or in our classroom. Children need to be prepared with appropriate shoes and outerwear.
- **Tuesday:**  
Library- Will be during our reading block so only students who are ready for a new book will go to the library for checkout. Books that are returned will be quarantined for at least 72 hours before being returned to the shelf.

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# FRIDAY WORK/MEETINGS

Students will bring a folder home on Thursday with a math and/or language arts page to complete on Friday. The Friday work and folder is due on Monday. If students have unfinished class work from the week, those assignments will come home on Friday's as well. Please use Fridays to help them catch up.

Students may be invited to come to school on Fridays for additional interventions or enrichment. The scheduled block of time for this is between 10:30 am – 12:55 pm with lunch following from 12:55 pm – 1:25 pm. Crossing guards will only be available at 10:30 am and 1:25 pm, so students would need to stay for the duration of the time unless arrangements are made with a parent to pick them up. This time is by invitation only. I will arrange this in advance if your student is expected on Friday.

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# COVID Procedures

- We will be washing or sanitizing hands each time students enter or leave the classroom and if they come into contact with shared supplies.
- Each night student desks and chairs will be sanitized. Furniture used by all students will be sanitized between each use.
- Students will have their own supplies and text books.
- Books that are shared will sit in 72 hour quarantine before they are used again.
- Children are expected to wear their masks while in the building and in line outside.
- Everyday there will only be one school lunch choice instead of two. If students bring a home lunch, They are encouraged to bring it in a container that can be thrown away.

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# In the Morning

Students will line up by the third grade doors. Look for “Miss Roberts” written in chalk to show you where you line up. When you arrive at school you will need to go straight to your line, so plan on coming just before the first bell rings at 8:25.

Students will not be allowed to play on the playground before school starts! You will need to wear your mask when you are on school grounds.

I will come out and get you when the bell rings.



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This year we are working with Canvas. Canvas is a digital platform that will hold student assignments for math, reading, writing and science. For the first few days of school I will be training your students how to login and use this program.

In case of a school closure or a student is at home for an extended period they will still be able to login to Canvas and do their work from home.

# Miscellaneous

- **Due to COVID our school has decided that we will be unable to allow students to bring in any type of birthday treat. We will celebrate as a class in a fun way, but it will need to be without treats from home.**
- **Homework will be minimal. Students will be asked to read every school night, including Fridays, for 20 minutes. Starting in third grade, independent reading is a grade on the report card. Students will bring home a monthly reading calendar to record their minutes. Spelling/vocabulary lists will come home most Thursdays to be studied for the following week's tests.**
- **Flash cards will be sent home to help students with their math facts. Please practice them as part of their daily routine.**

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
