Video Call Button

New to Hayden Peak this year is a Video Call Box next to the office door in the foyer.

Please push the call button to talk to the office staff.



CHECKING IN

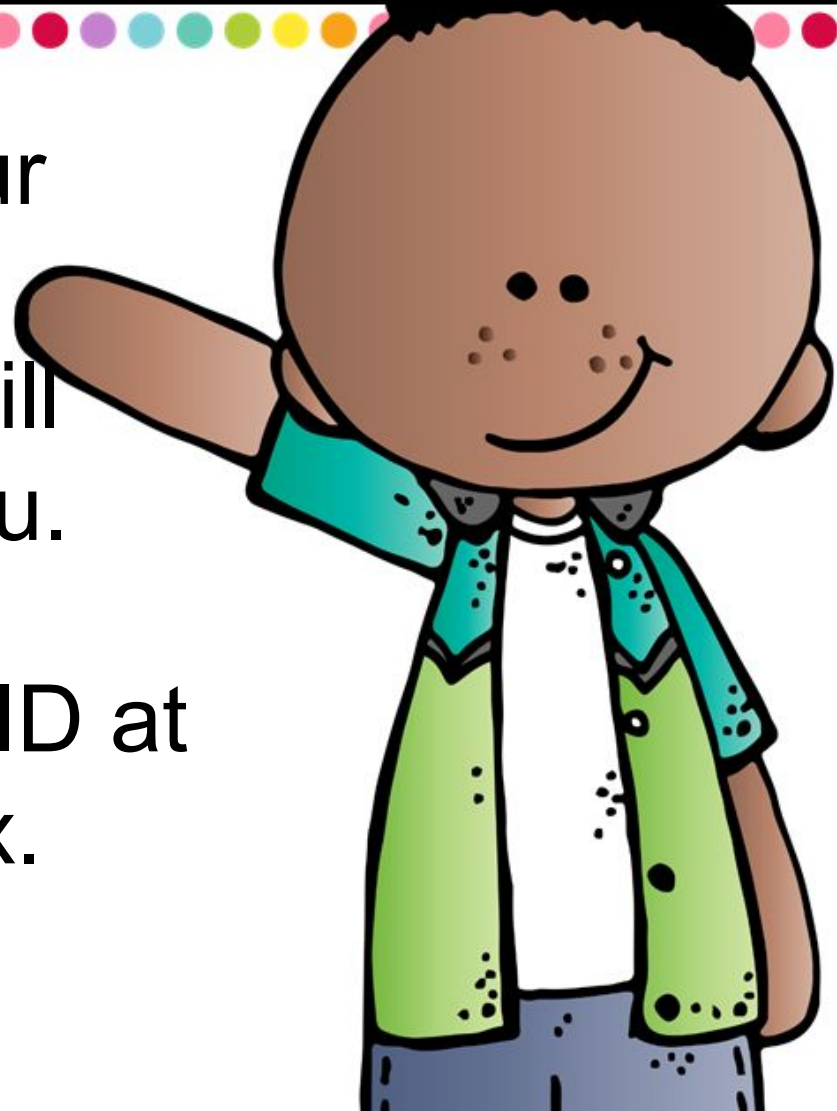
If your student is late to school please bring them to the office and push the Call Button and let us know who your student is and why they are late. We will buzz them through the door to head to class.



CHECKING OUT

If you need to check your student out of school please call ahead. We will have them waiting for you.

Be prepared to show ID at the Video Call Box.



Checking Out #2

When you arrive to check your student out, push the Call Button on the new Video Call box next to the office door in the foyer, show your ID and we will send your student out to you in the foyer.



Dropping Stuff Off

In order to keep our office staff safe and minimize traffic in the office, if you need to drop off a lunch, coat, backpack, etc. You may leave it on the bench in the front foyer and use the Video Call Button to let us know that you have brought something for your child. We will get it to their class.



Visitors

Due to the current pandemic situation, we will be limiting visitors and ask that parents do not enter the building with their students. If you need to come in, please come to the office first.

SL County Health Dept – Guidelines for School Districts

“Below are the general guidelines to manage COVID symptoms, confirmed exposures, and confirmed positive cases amongst students and staff of K-12 schools, based on guidance from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). 1. If a student or employee is symptomatic with any of the symptoms listed below, they should not come to school and should seek COVID testing at a location listed at coronavirus.utah.gov.”



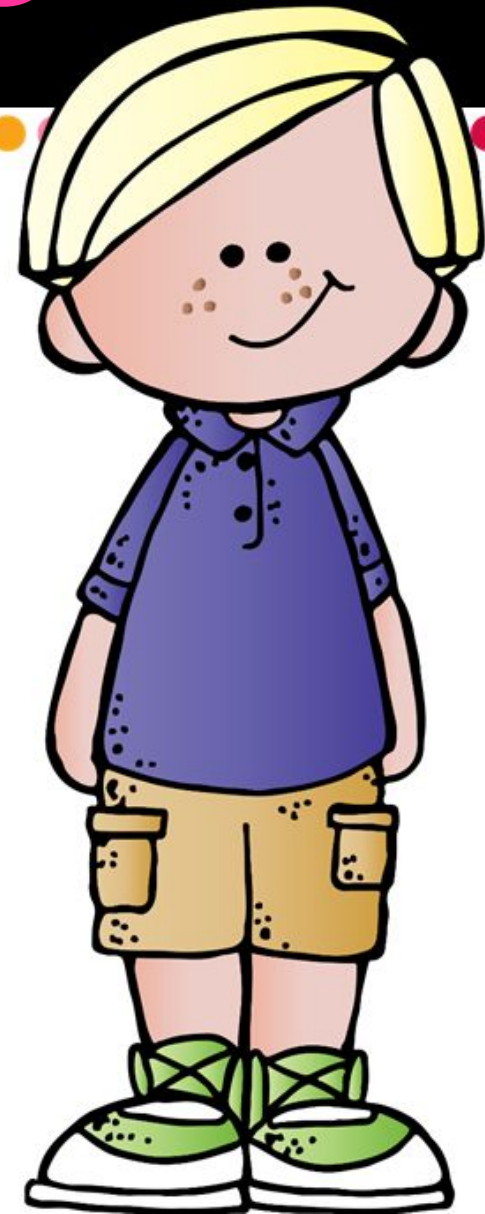
Symptoms
