- o Book Fair: Melanie Morrey/Britney Suddarth - Heidi Mortensen is coming to share about Paper Pie book fair. 50% back in books, or up to 25% in cash. She only needs 2-3 weeks notice to get all the

inventory she needs. She can also do a smaller fair to piggy back on other events such as STEM night or a holiday assembly. They have a grant matching program so if we have a grant to go towards books they'll match up to 50%. The price point for the books are \$5-8 for paper backs, activity books are \$5-15, hard cover books are \$15-20. Heidi gets a 17% commission on the book fair. Paper Pie does not sell Battle of the Books, popular series, or well known authors for teacher classrooms.

Reach For The Stars is a 2 week reading challenge and Paper Pie gives prizes for reading and pledges they sign. They read for 15 minutes each day and they will still earn a book if they don't get pledges to sign. Aiming for 10 pledges of \$10 for each student.
