

## Hayden Peak SCC Meeting

September 13, 2019

1. New (Principal Fisher, Teacher Regan Stowell, Parent Amy Glaubenslee) and current member introductions made
2. Sharra Palmer made a request on behalf of the 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers and students for funding help for the students to attend Junior. Achievement's Biz town.
  - a. The cost is \$5/student, approx. \$750, and then \$850 for the bussing, for a total of \$1600.
  - b. Grants from Walmart, Target, Real were made as well, will find out in December what the results are. (Hopefully cost will be covered from the grants) PTA is also willing to pitch in \$500.
  - c. We have \$6000 in our account right now, but no further \$ coming in.
  - d. Tina motioned that we use \$500 to support Biztown, Liz seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative to set aside \$500.
3. Elect new positions-
  - a. Tina voted as chair for the year, Leslee McGee will continue as vice chair, and Liz Johnson will be secretary.
4. PTA Fundraiser next week- we were encouraged to support the Fun Run as the SCC.
  - a. Amy Wilde explained all the preparations that have gone into advertising, getting sponsors, getting the kids excited. They have a sign up genius on Facebook for volunteers to help in shifts from 9:20-11:30 and 12:30-2.
5. Discussed safe walking routes and the impact of more middle schoolers walking by Hayden Peak and also at the Grizzly and 78<sup>th</sup> S. crossing. There are a lot more elementary students staying on the east side of Grizzly. Also need to watch for students crossing at the faculty parking lot exit, perhaps have teachers there as crossing guards. Ms. Fisher and Ms. Ford said they have been watching that area and will continue to do so.
  - a. Tina said she'd talk to Cindy Jacobson about the possibility of changing the crossing on 78<sup>th</sup> S. being switched to the east side of Grizzly as most of the kids are headed that way.
